

**PLAINTIFFS' MOTION FOR
TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER**


Now come the Plaintiffs, Rhode Island Public Employees Retiree Coalition, et al., Bristol/Warren Regional School Employees, Local 581, AFSCME, Council 94, AFL-CIO et al., and Rhode Island Council 94, AFSCME, AFL-CIO Locals: RHODE ISLAND COUNCIL 94, AFSCME, AFL-CIO LOCALS: BOYS & GIRLS TRAINING SCHOOL, LOCAL 314, AFSCME, COUNCIL 94, AFL-CIO, et al., and City of Cranston Police Officers, International Brotherhood of Police Officers, Local 301, et al., pursuant to G.L. 1956 § 8-2-14 and Super. Ct. R. Civ. P. 65, and hereby move for a temporary restraining order prohibiting the Defendants, their agents, servants, officers, and employees, and anyone acting in concert with them, from implementing the provisions of Public Law 2011, chapters 408 and 409, the Rhode Island Retirement Security Act of 2011 ("RIRSA"), which will otherwise take effect on and after July 1, 2012 and which, among other things substantially impair Plaintiff retirees' and Plaintiffs' members' vested pension benefits.. In support thereof, Plaintiffs rely upon the allegations of the complaints filed in the above-captioned actions, and a Memorandum of Law in Support of Motion for Temporary Restraining Order, and supporting verifications, to be filed forthwith on June 25, 2012.

Wherefore, Plaintiffs request that this Court issue a temporary restraining order and schedule the matter for hearing on preliminary injunction.






